

To remove the READ MORE from a **single blog post put this in Quode Options/Global Options/Custom CSS**

If you want to remove Post More just from one blog post, you need to include into this code the ID # of that post. For example, if you want to remove Read More button from the last blog post that have post-15841 (In order to get post ID #, right click the Blog in Blog lists then> inspect element)
